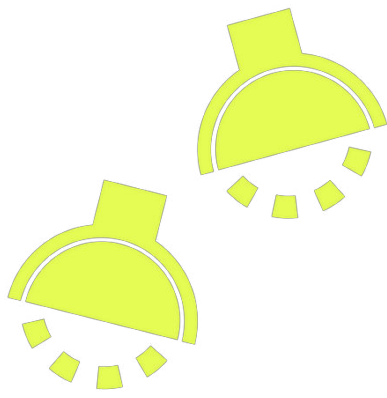
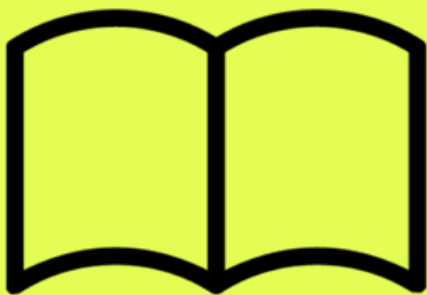

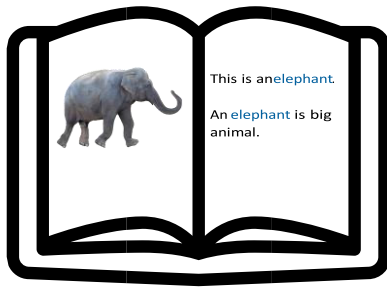

You can use the **Don Craig Room** for free to work on your **creative projects**.

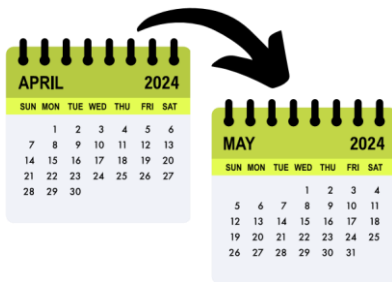


Examples of **creative projects** are

[Public Liability Insurance](#) helps cover costs

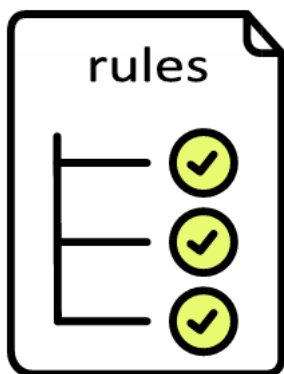
- If someone gets hurt when using the **Don Craig Room**

They will show you around **Laycock Street Community Theatre**.

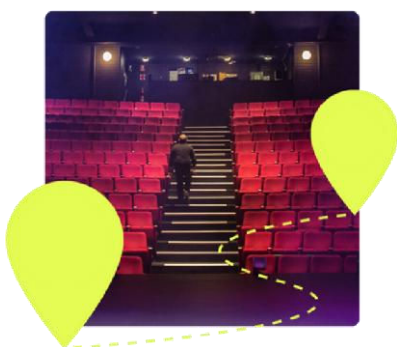
The role of the Theatre Staff

They will try to help you with things you need.

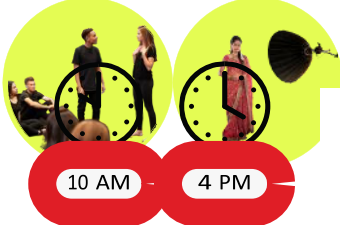

Theatre staff will use a list to check if you are able to use the **Don Craig Room**.

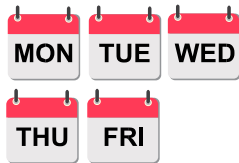
Checklist to use the **Don Craig Room**
