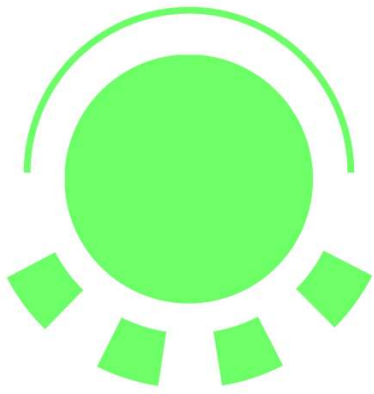
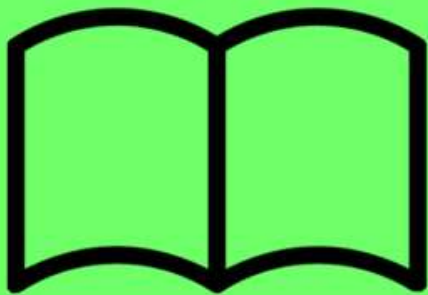

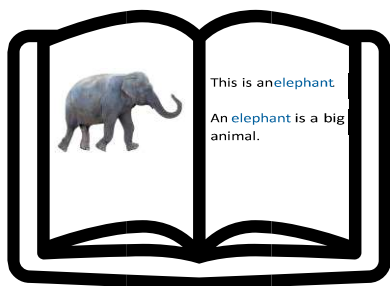

Greenlight Season is a [door-split model](#).

In a [door-split model](#) you can put on a show at **Laycock Street Community Theatre** or **The Peninsula Theatre**.

Then you and the theatre share the money from the tickets you sell



You do not need to pay the theatre any money before you put on your show.



We call this [less financial risk](#).

[Less financial risk](#) means there is less chance of losing money when you try something new.



Greenlight Season is for

- Artists who live on the **Central Coast**.
- **Central Coast** arts **collectives**.

Collectives means groups.



Greenlight Season is for **new creative work** only.

New creative work means this will be the first time you have put on this show for an audience.

We want to encourage artists to be **experimental**.



Experimental means artists try things that

- Are creative
- Makes people think.
- Is different to what other people are doing.
- Is adventurous.

How we will judge your application



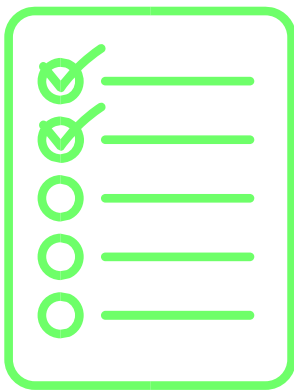

If your idea will interest the community.

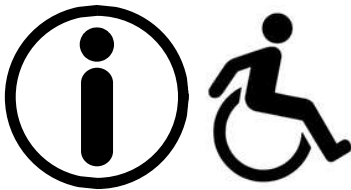
